The Suzy Lamplugh Plate will be awarded to the lady competitor over 16 who starts the most
events throughout the season. Helms: 2 points per race; Crews 1 point per race.

(Maximum age in brackets on day of race)

RACE FEES

Each helm must pay race fees. Fees for members: £20 annually / £5 per day. Fees for non-
members: £25 annually / £5 per day. Only NBC members will be awarded Club trophies.

BOAT PARKING

Members wishing to park dinghies or tenders on the Club grounds between 1st April to 30th
September should enquire at the Members bar where a fee of £30 is payable. There is limited
space available and applications will be dealt with on a first come first served basis.

Craft must be on a well-maintained trailer, with fully inflated tyres and must be removed from the
Club grounds by September 30th. Craft parked without paying the fee will be removed.
